7:45 Depart FMB, IOIO Crossroads Place, High Ridge, MO.
9:30 Reststop
11:00-1:00 Palms Grill - A restored 1935 Café, The Palm's serve blue plate specials featuring Meatloaf and their specialty homemade pies. Photo opportunities with a 19 foot "Bunyan Giant", the J.H. Hawes Grain Elevator and Museum, one of a kind Clock Tower and a Route 66 Gift Shop.
1:20-3:20 Funk Prairie Home - Tour the restored home of the famous Illinois Senator Lafayette Funk. The founder of the Chicago Union Stock Yard and Funk Seeds, Mr. Funk's seed company pioneered the hybrid corn which is found in Illinois fields today.
4:30 Arrive and Check into the Holiday Inn for a Welcome Reception of Wine and Cheese. *Be sure to check under the pillows for a Klondike Clue!*
5:45 Depart for Dinner at Alexander Steakhouse. Wild West themed restaurant complete with Steak dinner sets the perfect stage for this Murder Mystery.

8:30 Depart for the William Staerke Planetarium
9:00 - 10:00 William Staerke Planetarium - Take a live-narrated tour of the wonders of tonight's sky, accompanied by some of the legendary stories of the ancient sky.
12:30-4:00 Arrive at the Jail House Inn - Just like Otis on Mayberry, you will want to check yourself into this jail. Tour the historic 1879 jail turned Bed and Breakfast with themed jail cells. In the downstairs dungeon where they kept the worst criminals, is now the winery called the Drunk Tank. Enjoy lunch at the 36 Saloon. Bonnie and Clyde will be there to greet you on this tour. Board the coach with Bonnie and head to one of the most photographed covered bridges in the nation, "The Bridgeton Mill", the oldest continually operating mill in Indiana. Take home a souvenir bag of freshly made pancake mix. John Dillinger was put in this jail for robbing their local bank.
4:00 - 5:30 Bob Ross' Painting Class - paint your own masterpiece: Instructions provided. Grab a Canvas and brush, then take home a souvenir painting of an Alaskan Landscape with Northern lights.
5:45 Hardy's Flying Reindeer Ranch - The Reindeer mystery is solved. As your coach arrives you're likely to find the Klondike Kid running across your path with a reindeer sure to follow.
