Our first stop will be at the National Transportation Museum. This 42-acre museum, both indoors and outdoors, was founded in 1944 and restores and preserves displays of a variety of vehicles spanning 15 decades of American history. (Cars, boats, aircraft, locomotives and railroad equipment) This museum is the home to a research library of transportation - related memorabilia and documents. Its grounds include Barrett's Tunnel, one of the first Railroad Tunnels built west of the Mississippi river.

Next we will have lunch at Lombardo's Italian Restaurant. Our menu includes: House salad, Chicken Parmesan, White Pasta, Green Beans, Bread, Beverage and Dessert.

Our last stop will be Boeing's James S. McDonnell Prologue Room. Our tour here takes us to the history of flight, space exploration and advanced technology. The exhibits portray more than 100 years of aviation progress from the company's earliest biplanes to its latest jets and spacecraft. Hundreds of scale models, dioramas, paintings, photographs and videos tell the story of the companies that make up Boeing Company today. The centerpiece of the exhibit is the full-size engineering development fixtures of the Mercury and Gemini spacecraft.
