WHAT DOES FARMERS AND MERCHANTS BANK DO //WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and transaction history
- account balances and payment history
- credit history and credit scores

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	Farmers and Merchants Bank has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	 Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies, credit card companies, and financial service providers.
